Mr. Burkett reviewed the Reconstruction schedule submitted by Mr. McCullough which listed the following:

2019 - North Hassel Road is completed

2020 - McCullough Road from Charleston to Bend

2021 - Daley Road from 258 to Wellsite

2022 - Seidle Road from Grove to Fullingmill

2023 - Bend road from 258 to top of hill.

Mr. Burkett stated that a lot depended on Road Bonds. Further discussion regarding Daley Road being paved, application of millings and under drains.

Agility list submitted by Mr. McCullough was not read, but the board stated that they would be meeting with Penn Dot next week. Mr. McCullough advised the board that they would then know how much funding available for Scratch and Seal coating. Further discussion on proposed roads to seal included; N. Hassel, Winner Circle, Charleston from well to 62 and Mallard Way.

Mr. Falkner asked about Swingle Hill, response from Mr. McCullough and Mr. Dunn concluded that the problem with the Dixon driveway is caused by culvert not being kept cleaned out by resident.

The board reviewed cost and application of Gold Star dust control product and unanimously agreed to purchase the 275-gallon tote at the price of \$4,999.00 to be billed in 2020.
