The monthly meeting of the Jefferson Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Mr. McCullough on August 8, 2022, at 7:00pm at the Jefferson Township Building, 7407 Lamor Rd, Mercer, PA 16137.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and Roll Call was taken. In attendance were Supervisors Richard McCullough, Tyler Angermeier and Secretary/Treasurer Rachel Nickel, along with the sign in sheet. John Burkett was absent.

A motion was made by Mr. McCullough to approve the minutes from July 11, 2022 Supervisors Meeting. Seconded by Mr. Angermeier. Motion passed with 2 yes votes.

Motion was made by Mr. McCullough and seconded by Mr. Angermeier to pay the following payables for July 11, 2022 through August 8, 2022. Motion passed with 2 yes votes.

Mr. McCullough advised them they could fix their culvert on their property. After he finishes Seidle he will bring millings over and crown the center of the road to help with the storm water run offs. Mr. McCullough will also access the culvert that may need a storm drain box.

Mr. McCullough explained that the RV Village Camping Resort is putting in more camping sites. Chief Lockard and Mr. McCullough had a meeting with the manager on safety matters with the park. They agreed that the road ways for emergency services are safe.

Mr. McCullough read the Charter of Communications correspondence letter to the township.

A motion was made by Mr. McCullough to accept the April 2022 tax additions and exonerations of real estate additions 3 \$248.07 real estate exons 2 \$65.54 per captia exons 39 \$390.00 per capita additions 19 \$190.00. Seconded by Mr. Angermeier.
